

RESPOND

Question 1. When you think about what Christ "says" to you through his life, death and resurrection, what words come to your heart and mind?

Question 2. In what ways is your life a reflection of Jesus?

Question 4. How can you "shine" brighter for Jesus in your life and in your relationships today.
